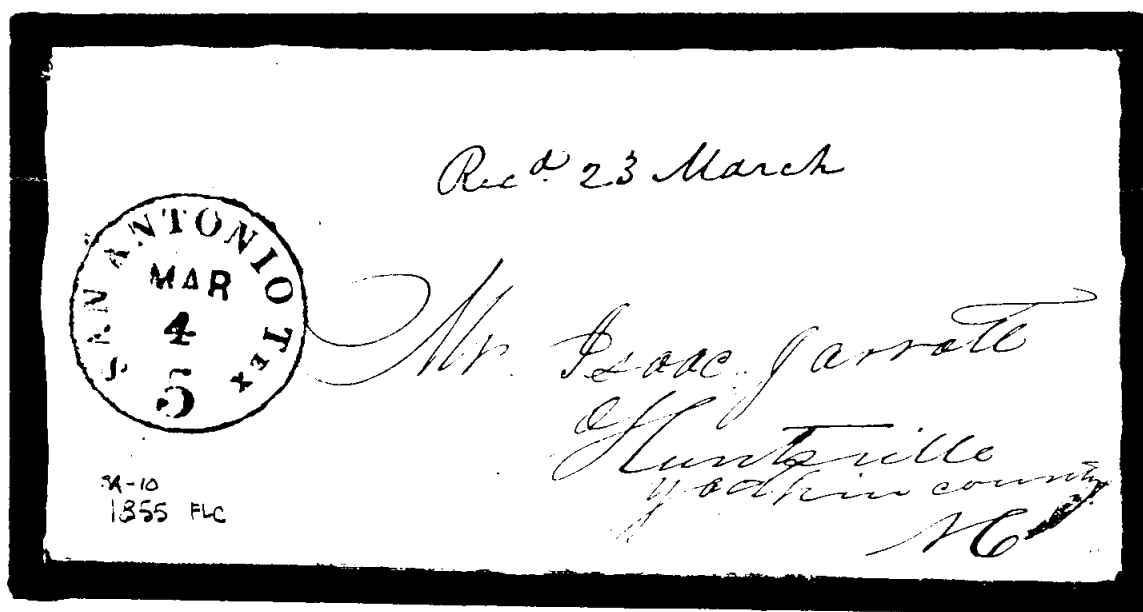

Another achievement by the Texas Postal History Society has been accomplished. The production of its first treatise. This manuscript, by Richard Wardsworth, titled "Postal History of El Paso County, Texas", has been reproduced and is now available for distribution. A copy costs \$10, postage prepaid.

His publication consists of 125 pages of information, supplemented by more than 100 illustrations and drawings. It treats the postmarks used, the mail service provided, the discontinued post offices of the county and much useful historical information about a very large county. This is a definitive resource for any and all Texas Postal Historians. Get yours early, before the supply runs out. Perhaps this is an appropriate time to review some of the other milestones that have resulted via the Texas Postal History Society and its members. First is the Texas Postal History Society Journal, started in 1975 it will shortly complete its 15th volume. This was followed in 1980 by Charles Deaton's publication of the "Wheat Study" under the title, "Texas Postal History Handbook". In 1981 the T.P.H.S. and its members were instrumental in the establishment of an "Old Time Post Office" at the Institute of Texian Culture in San Antonio. Each year since 1975, we have held our "Annual Meeting and Trading Session". While they are not always attended by a large portion of our membership, they are always the focal point for much enthusiasm by those who do come. Another recent milestone, was the inauguration of the "Cover Auction" which has been professionally handled and well recieved by the membership. So far we had three of these auctions. If you have not participated you are missing out on a great deal to acquire Texas Covers at moderate prices. The final accomplishment of 1989 was the "Index to The Texas Postal History Society Journal". This index is complete for the first thirteen volumes. It was published and distributed to the membership without charge.

## ANNUAL MEETING AND TRADING SESSION

The next meeting and trading session for members of the T.P.H.S. will be held Oct. 27, 1990 in Waco, Texas. 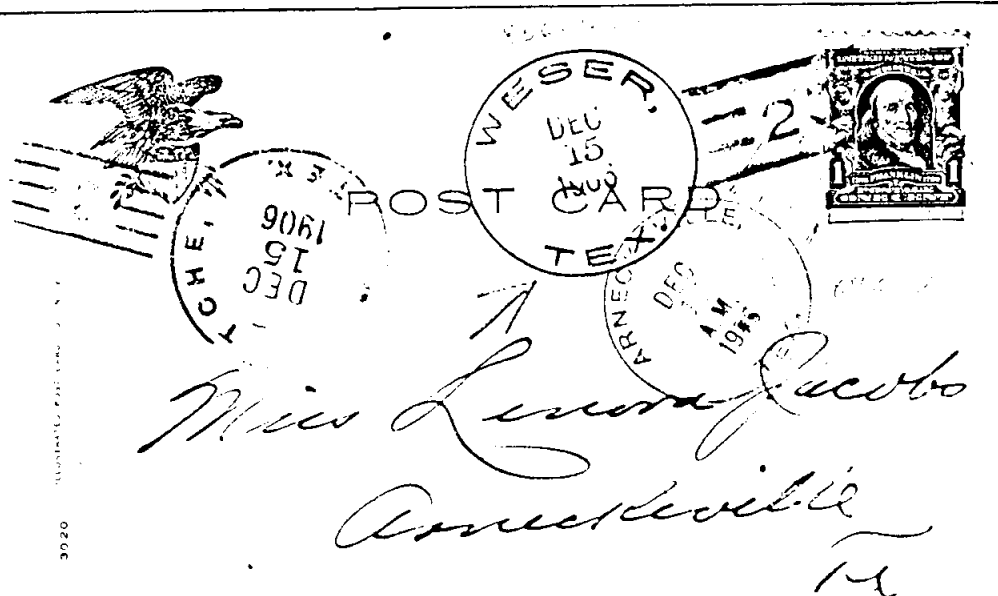
There may be 3000 postoffices in Texas that have used Doane cancels and to date I have 376 different listed as having used one or more of these cancels. A few of the postoffices used two different types of Doane cancels and some postoffices used the same type of cancel with a different number in the bars.

I would like to thank all those that sent in the information about the Texas Doane cancels. A large number of examples came from the Post Mark Collectors Club. Several members of the TPMS and a number of La Posta subscribers have also sent information about the Doanes they have.

The number of each type of Doane cancel examined along with the earliest and latest dates are given below.

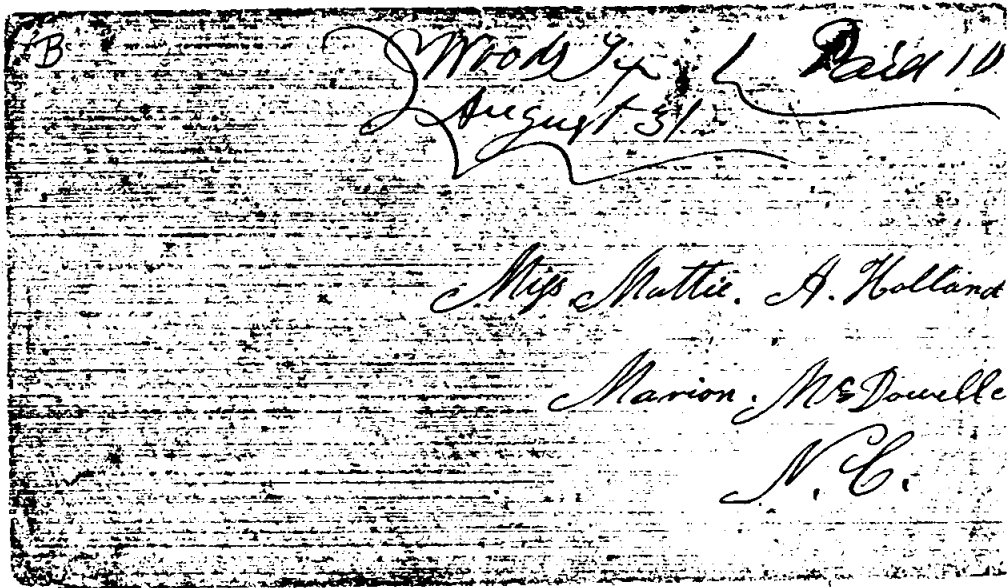
